The orchestra is not only a popular and prestigious flagship of the University, but also fulfils a number of indispensable educational functions. It provides our instrumentalists with practical experience in orchestral and concerto playing, and our opera students with opportunities to sing in full-scale productions with orchestra. It allows conducting students to work with full orchestra, and now also gives the winners of our orchestral composition competition the chance to hear their work performed.

An orchestra is, however, very expensive to run, and it has become increasingly difficult to find money in the SACM concert budget to fund all the costs of the orchestra. Apart from being unable to meet its day-to-day expenses, the orchestra has also had to refuse several invitations to take part in national festivals and tours, due to lack of financial resources.

In view of the above, the Director and Concert Committee of the SACM have established a special fund for the orchestra. Any donation, however small (or large!) is welcome.
